### **KALAMAZOO AREA MATHEMATICS AND SCIENCE CENTER**

The Kalamazoo Area Mathematics and Science Center (KAMSC) announces the following position:

#### **Mathematics & Information Technology Teacher for Accelerated Program Fall 2010**

KAMSC is a countywide public funded science and mathematics center for academically talented 9<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade students in Kalamazoo County. The center has a high national visibility and reputation for excellence. During its 24 years of operation, the program has provided rigorous and enriched mathematics and science courses for selected students of the Kalamazoo area. Students come to the center for half of their school day from area high schools. Classrooms are equipped with appropriate technology. The graphing calculator is used extensively within the mathematics curriculum. Teachers voluntarily work on Wednesday evenings for the purpose of interacting with students and providing additional support.

#### **REQUIREMENTS:**

Michigan Certification - Secondary Education. Must be able to teach Pre-Calculus and Information Technology (IT). Major in mathematics; Masters Degree in one of the two content areas; three years teaching experience; willingness to participate in responsibilities at times other than the usual school hours; and desire to work with advanced level students under innovative conditions. The position assignment includes Pre-Calculus and 9<sup>th</sup> grade Information Technology. The applicant is required to be knowledgeable in Microsoft Office Suite.

#### **PREFERRED:**

Applicants having the ability to teach AP Calculus are encouraged to apply. The mathematics teacher should demonstrate the ability to use multiple instructional and assessment strategies making extensive use of the graphing calculator and other technologies.

The Information Technology teacher should be able to demonstrate programming knowledge in a language, such as Visual Basic, and the use of Microsoft Office including Word, Excel, PowerPoint, Access, and Publisher. Should be knowledgeable of Windows 7 and Office Suite 2007. The teacher should be flexible and able to work with students successfully in situations other than the traditional classroom and a willingness to incorporate community resources into the instructional experience. Preference will be given to applicants with experience in working collaboratively with colleagues.
