

# Reviewer Instructions for Refereed Articles for Media Spectrum:

By author request only, *Media Spectrum*, the journal of MAME, will consider articles to be published as peer-reviewed research. *Media Spectrum* is a professional journal that provides an open forum for educators who are concerned with issues arising from the practice of information leadership and school librarianship; the peer-reviewed research articles are designed to complement

The articles must be either research-based or an example of best practice supported with published research, and be of a scholarly standard. Major foci include collaborative curriculum development, resource-based learning, information technology and its integration into learning/teaching programs, information management and literature.

The following information is designed to help reviewers evaluate the article submitted for *Media Spectrum*. If revisions are recommended, reviewers should be as specific as possible in delineating the changes and should indicate which changes are recommended and which are mandatory.

The reviewer should return the Reviewer Instructions form to the *Media Spectrum* Peer Review Coordinator as soon as possible (but no later than 3 weeks after receiving the article).
